Carolina Shade Sails is pleased to announce the completion of a two sail shade structure at LabCorp—Project Infinity in Burlington, NC. This project was designed by Landscape Architect Tim Knowles at Borum, Wade Associates and PNP Architects.



The tension membrane shade structure is a two sail overlapping structure that adds much needed shade to LabCorp's renovated outdoor dining area. The sails enhance the overall aesthetics of the existing building while complementing the new updated addition. The three point sails are Commercial 95 shade cloth in Turquoise and Aquatic Blue to complement the LabCorp logo. This fabric is distributed by local manufacturer Glen Raven Mills.



Two overlapping sails cover the 36'x32' patio. The sails are supported by two custom designed brackets mounted on the building and 3 steel columns for support. The column heights are 13', 15' and 17' while the custom brackets are mounted 20' and 17' above the patio to add height and architectural interest.

This structure is Wind Rated for 170 mph with cover off and 120 mph wind load with cover on.

LabCorp loves the shade sails and the updated look the structure gives their building.
